Happy New Year! We hope that you had an enjoyable Christmas break and are ready to support your child with their new learning during this Spring Term.

Topics this term

Writing: We will be building up to a variety of genres including suspense stories, biographies and poetry.

Reading: We will be developing our ability to answer inference and deduction style questions.

Spelling and Grammar: We will be revising different tenses, word classes and sentence structures. We will be revising the year 3/4 word lists and spelling rules already covered.

Maths: Using the maths mastery approach we will be developing our speed, reasoning and problem-solving skills involving multiplication, division and fractions.

Geography: UK and USA, focusing on cities, populations, weather and climate.

Science: Teeth and digestion

Art and Design: Linked to our arts' week topic- Spain

Computing: We continue to learn about online safety, programming and coding.

Reading and Spelling

Please listen to your child read every night.

Ask questions about what they have read to check their level of understanding.

Explore what different words mean by using a dictionary.

Ask your child to summarise what they have read using concise sentences.

Homework

Children will be given homework once a week. Homework must be completed to a high standard and **returned by Tuesday**.

In addition to this, children are expected to:

- Read for a minimum of 15 minutes each evening.
- Learn spellings for the test each Friday.
- Log onto Times Table Rock Stars and practice their times tables.

There will be occasions when extra work or revision is given out. Please support your child with their learning at home.

Homework Learning Challenges

Each term there will be 'Home Learning Challenges' to complete with some of the tasks linked to the current topic. There will be 10 cross-curricular activities and children will have the challenge of completing all 10 activities by the end of the term.
