### Topics this term

**English:** Year 1 will focus on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing.

**Maths:** We will be counting forwards and backwards up to 100. We will be practising writing numbers 1 to 20 in numerals and words. We will be identifying one more and one less than a number.



**History:** 'My Community'. We will be looking at Wandsworth and locating local areas on maps.

**Science:** 'Animals Including Humans'. We will be finding out about different animals and labelling body parts.

**Phonics:** Year 1 follow the phonics scheme Read Write Inc. We will be recapping set 1 and 2 sounds.

### Reading

Listen to your child read every night and sign their reading record. These are to be kept at home and brought in once a half term for us to check.

### P.E. Kit

We are asking children to come to school in their PE kit on the days that they have PE lessons - for year 1 this term that is **Thursday** and **Friday**.

Children will also need to wear trainers or plimsolls to school on their PE days.

### Uniform

The school uniform consists of a light blue polo shirt, a West Hill sweatshirt, black or grey trousers or skirt and dark shoes. **Please label all uniform.**

### Covid and handwashing

On arrival at school and at various points throughout the school day we ask the children to wash or sanitise their hands.

### How you can help your child

You can help your child to do the best they can by listening to them read and asking them questions about what they have read. You could also take a trip to the library.

#### Counting EVERYTHING!

Maybe the number of lamp posts on the way to school, or steps taken to get into bed. Counting aloud forward and backwards. Get your child to help you cook - measuring ingredients and sharing food out.

#### Physical Development

Go to the park and have some fun! Explore what our bodies can do. "How high can you jump?", "How fast can you run?", "How high can you stretch?"  
Improving smaller movements like pencil grip by using small construction toys or play operation!

Please ensure that your child is present and on time each morning as this will help them to do the best that they possibly can this year. The school gates are open from **8.35** and children can make their way to their classroom from **8.40**.
