Reading at home



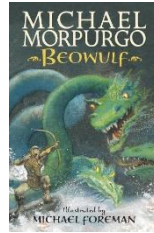

We believe in ourselves.

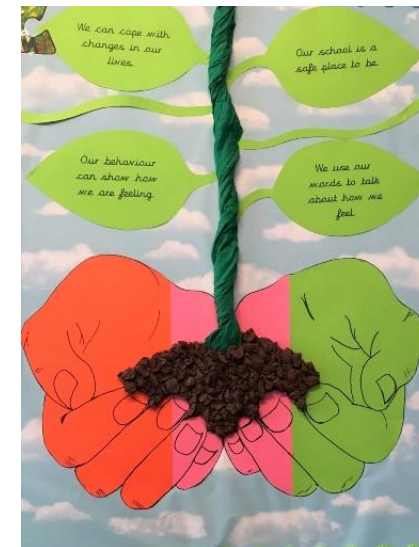
We all learn in our own way and in our own way.
